Attitude	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - thinks about feedback as a dialogue between professionals - thinks about feedback as an opportunity to grow and iterate the project - seeks out feedback from peers and teachers when needed
Responsibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - manages own emotions during feedback sessions - is able to regulate emotions and affections when giving and receiving feedback
