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The purpose and principles of the course:

The aim of the course is to create photographs and photography-based works by using the knowledge you have gained about the representation of space and time. You will learn to apply your previous knowledge in the most free and creative way in the creation process. Prepare students for successful admission to the MA, so that they can create independent, unique thematic works. You can apply the knowledge you have acquired so far in creating your pictures in an individual way.

Supporting creative work with research methods, analysis and evaluation of research results, written and oral (presentation) formulation, as well as written and oral formulation and presentation of creative projects.

Learn to formulate an independent project theme, set creative goals and present them, discuss and evaluate them in a professional environment

Additional goals of the course:

The development of the conscious use of photographic vision, in which the student's independent decision prevails. Deepen the ability to make a conscious choice between photographic specifics, thereby promoting the strengthening of an independent approach and the understanding of autonomous and applied photographic areas. To continue practicing and perfecting the use of different formulation methods and applied techniques that can be assigned to previous art programs.

Topics to be covered in the course:

Space and time play a prominent role in both human existence and the genres of photography. In the last semester of the BA training, it is worth looking back and summarizing what you have learned so far and planning, even rethinking the future, trying out and deepening new methods and genres. Accordingly, the focus of the creative work is on the professional execution of the applied projects, summarizing the knowledge acquired during the training and experimentation.

Characteristics of learning organization/process organization: The course, the nature of each session and their schedule:

Session 1: Presentation and discussion of all semester topics and tasks Session 2: Discussion of task 1.1, presentation of pictures taken for task 1.2. Group consultation. Studio photography.

Session 3: Presentation of the pictures for task 1. Individual consultation. Studio photography.

Session 4: Presentation and discussion of task 2

Session 5: Presentation of the pictures for task 2., Group consultation.

Session 6: Presentation of the pictures for task 2. Individual consultation.

Students' duties and tasks:

1. Dream assignment

Taking pictures at a professional level in some special applied photography genre. The chosen genre can be reportage, food, object, building, fashion, portrait photography, etc. It is necessary to strive to produce images of a highly professional level in the given genre, based on a fictitious or real assignment. The goal is to acquire knowledge and skills that can be used to successfully complete assignments on the applied photography labor market.

Time allotted to solve the task: 2 weeks

2. Timeshelter

"If the Europe of the future is already unrealizable, let's choose the Europe of the past. It's simple: what has no future, vote for the past." (Georgi Goszpodinov: Timeshelter, detail)

More and more people feel that they have no future, so they flee to the past. They cherish memories, conserve values, and aim to preserve these values for themselves or even for the whole society. There are several possible reasons for the development of this phenomenon, the most typical of which is a sense of losing existence, loss of faith in broken development, existential uncertainty or fear of impending environmental disasters and wars raging nearby.

During the solution of the task, we must strive to formulate the unusual phenomena that arise as a result of this feeling or our thoughts related to it in the language of photography.

Time allotted to solve the task: 4 weeks

3.1 Writing a synopsis

Writing a text related to a photo series on a topic of your own choosing, in which the essence and purpose of the planned photo series must be concisely stated, as well as the method of implementation must be described. Length: 3000-4000 characters

Submission deadline: Format: editable Google/Word document.

Making a series of photos as stated in the synopsis (task 3.1). (Your own title is placed on the horizontal line.)

Quantitative requirements: a series of at least 5 images.

Submission deadline: Date specified in Google Classroom during the semester.
